Eligibility Requirements:

- o Current high school senior who will be enrolled, full-time (12+ units), in an accredited 2-year or 4-year university for the 2024-2025 school year
- o Have at least a 3.0 grade point average
- o Attend a high school located in Tulare County, California
- o Have an interest in nature related activities, major, or job aspirations (i.e. field researcher, environmentalist, wildlife vet technician, park ranger, conservationist, etc.)
- o Cannot be a member or the child of a member of Latitude 36 Outdoors Club

Application must include:

- o Typed and completed **Student Information Sheet**
- o Typed **Personal Statement** (500 word max)
- o Current **high school transcripts**
 - o Note: An official or unofficial transcript *will be* accepted as long as it is from the school registrar's office. A "screenprint" will not be accepted.

If any of the above items are missing from your application packet after March 15, 2024, your application will NOT be considered.

Award Information:

Latitude 36 will be distributing a one-time scholarship of \$1000 for the 2024-2025 school year. Only final scholarship recipients will be notified via email by **April 15, 2024**; runners-up will NOT be contacted. Each recipient must show proof of enrollment of at least 12 units at an accredited 2-year or 4-year university by **September 30, 2024**, in order to receive the money. Each scholarship recipient must have a PayPal or Venmo account in order to receive scholarship funds. Each scholarship recipient must be willing to allow Latitude 36 to announce his/her name, picture, and excerpts from the written response online and in other media.
